FIBROIDS

ENDOMETRIOSIS

What it is?

Noncancerous growths in or on the uterine wall.

Tissue similar to the uterine lining growing outside the uterus.

Where it appears

Inside or on the uterus.

Outside the uterus, often around pelvic organs.

Type of pain

Pressure, heaviness, or dull pain

Sharp, intense, often debilitating pain.

Period changes

Heavy bleeding or longer periods.

Severe cramps and pain before or during periods.

Common symptoms

Pelvic pressure, frequent urination, lower back pain, painful intercourse, enlarged abdomen.

Chronic pelvic pain, painful intercourse, pain with bowel movements or urination, fatigue, bloating, nausea.

Fertility impact

May affect fertility depending on size and location.

More commonly linked to infertility.

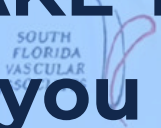
Treatment options

UFE, myomectomy, or hysterectomy.

Hormonal therapy, pain management, or laparoscopic surgery.
